UNIVERSITY OF ZARAGOZA







ZARAGOZA: THE CITY

- Fifth Spanish city in terms of population (around 700,000 inhabitants)
- Equally distant of around 300 km from Madrid, Valencia, Barcelona, Bilbao and Toulouse
- More that 2,000 years of history (influence of Romans, Muslims and Christians)
- Close to the beach and the mountains: Less that 2 hours away from the Mediterranean sea or the Pyrenes.
- Several important multinational companies: Groupe PSA (former GM), Inditex (Zara), Bosch-Siemens, Adidas, Valeo, Boots Healthcare, etc.
- Within the geographical center of the production of 80% of the of the Spanish GDP







GOOD REASONS TO LEARN SPANISH

- It is the official language in 21 countries
- It is the mother tongue of around 470 million people
- It is spoken by around 559 million people around the world
- It is the second language used for international communication
- It is the third language in the fields of politics, economy and culture.
- It is the second language in the USA (said to become soon the 1st one)
- It is a language with a long cultural tradition



UNIVERSITY OF ZARAGOZA



- It was founded in 1542 (around 480 years).
- Among their former students are: Nobel price (Santiago Ramón y Cajal, Medicine, 1906), the Spanish President (Manuel Azaña, 1930´s) and prominent scientist and thinkers (María Moliner, author of one of the most well-known Spanish dictionaries, Luis Oro Guiral, leading researcher in chemistry)
- It is a multidisciplinary Higher Education Institution, with 13 Schools, 3 Schools of Applied Sciences and 12 Research Centers
- It has a high research profile: for example, the supercomputer
 Caesaraugusta is located since February 2008 at the School of Sciences. It
 is one of the nodes of the supercomputer Mare Nostrum, that has the
 highest computer power in Europe and the ninth of the world.
- It has around 35,000 students, 3,900 lecturers and professors and 1,800 administrative staff

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

- This Faculty has mobility agreements for students in more that 20 different countries in 3 continents.
- During the last 3 years, an average of 180 international students have studied in our faculty each year. They come with the Erasmus program but also from Latin America or the USA.
- Considering the total number of In & Out Students this faculty is among the top-5 of the Faculties of Business and Economics in Spain.
- The University of Zaragoza is the 14th considering the whole European Union regarding IN students.



ENROLMENT PROCESS

- You will have a specific date for your enrollment: Check with the Intern. Office (ORI)
- You should select a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester
- You may choose any course of the School (except from the Double degree). But please remember:
 - The recommendations of your University
 - The available information: schedules, exam dates, location....
 - Electives have usually continuous evaluation
- You can choose the group you prefer when possible (except for some optional courses and English group subjects- there may be only one group)
- Once you select the group, you should go to class and do the exam in that group, and to your subgroup of practices (depending on your surname).
- Be careful, with the courses that have the same name in Business Administration (ADE) and Economics (ECO)






FAQs

Classes and exams are face to face


