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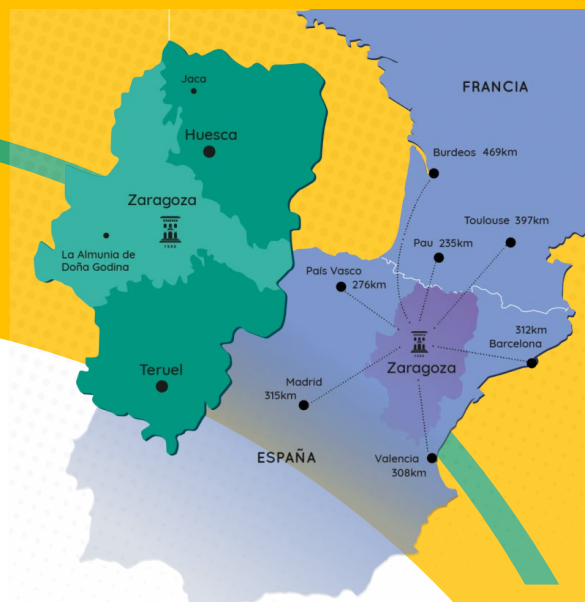

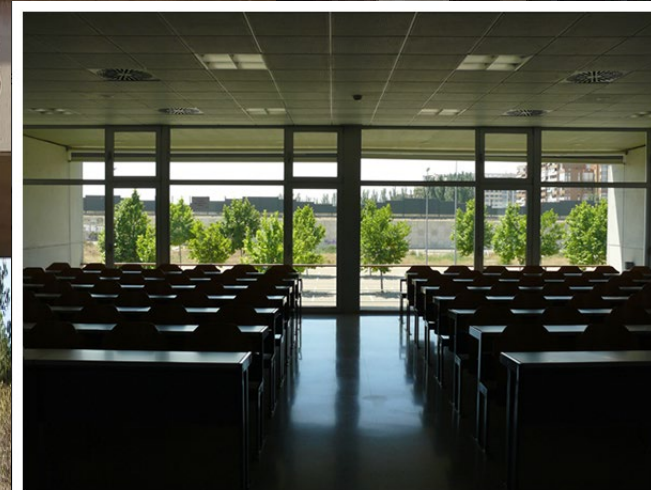
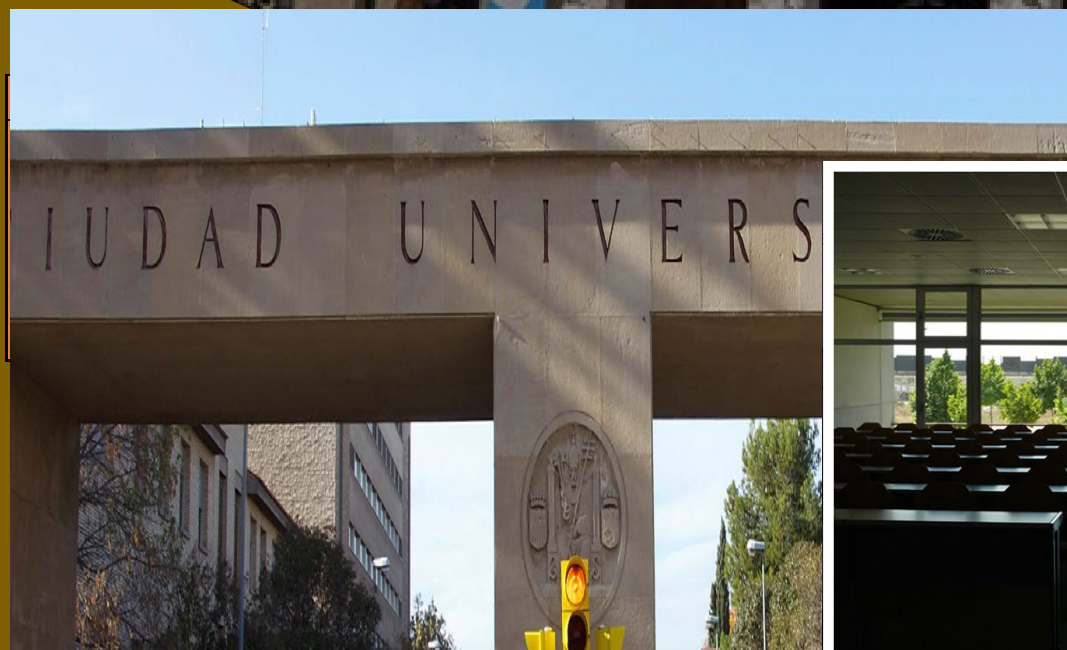

Frequently asked questions about doing Erasmus in Zaragoza

How much does it cost to live in Zaragoza as a student?

You will need approximately 600 euros per month to live without worries. Every student is different and the cost will depend on your lifestyle.

How is student life in Zaragoza?

Zaragoza is an excellent option for an Erasmus student since it is a large but very accessible city. In addition, the University of Zaragoza is full of international students with whom you will share unforgettable moments.

How much does a student accommodation cost in Zaragoza?

In Zaragoza, you can find rooms for rent from 275-375 euros per month. These are flats shared with other students and are usually the best rental option since they are generally the cheapest.

Train The Zaragoza Delicias train station is located very close to the city center, The building, which not only houses the train terminal but also Zaragoza's **bus station**, is an important transport interchange for the city, with all kinds of services available inside.

At the moment you can get from Zaragoza in about **two hours to** London-Stansted, Brussels-Charleroi, Bologna, Milan-Bergamo, Marrakech, Fez, Venice, Paris-Beauvais, Bucharest and Cluj-Napoca. Lisbon and Vienna are not returning for the time being. The offer is completed with domestic destinations such as Palma de Mallorca, Santiago de Compostela, Las Palmas de Gran Canaria and Tenerife.
